The ANTHC Tribal Response Program (TRP) had an extremely busy first quarter in hosting the 20th annual Alaska Tribal Conference on Environmental Management (ATCEM), held on October 26th-29th, 2015. The event boasted a celebrity studded keynote speaker panel, including Winona LaDuke and Dr. Ruth Etzel with over 480 participants registered. This year was also the first fully dedicated track to brownfields topics and issues, as well as a brownfields specific training held on October 29th. The track hosted ten presentations; eight with the duration of one hour and two thirty minute presentations. Brownfield presenters from across the nation participated in the event, including EPA project officers, TAB grantee representative, Ignacio Dayrit from CCLR, and TRPs from across the state. The success of the track and ATCEM as a whole was captured in high participant review ratings and the attendance at each brownfield presentation (often times with all seats filled up).
