Project Information


The Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) Project Management and Engineering Department (PM&E), in coordination with Tudor Centre Trust, is working to resurface roadways serving the **Alaska Native Health Campus**. Work will include paving, minor subgrade rehabilitation, as well as installing ADA improvements, signage, and striping. The majority of project work is expected to be completed during the 2019 construction season.

Safety in Construction Zones:

- Be alert to and follow directions of flaggers
- Allow additional time when traveling
- Watch for equipment and workers

What you Need to Know:

- Ambassador Drive will **OPEN** Thursday, August 8th.
- Beginning Thursday, August 8th, Tudor Centre Drive (between Tudor Road and Ambassador Drive) will be CLOSED to through traffic for at least one week. Alternate access is described and shown on the map below.
 - \Rightarrow Access Primary Care Center Building (2) from Diplomacy Drive.
 - \Rightarrow Access overflow parking lot from Ambassador Drive.
 - \Rightarrow Diplomacy Drive will have restricted access due to closure at west intersection with Tudor Centre Dr.
 - \Rightarrow People Mover routes 20, 25 and 55 on Diplomacy Drive will be redirected to the stops on Tudor Centre Drive.
