- Applications are due **January 24th, 2020**
- Three undergraduate internships: May 18th to June 19th (5wks)
- Three graduate internships: May 25th to July 17th (8wks)
- Undergraduate internship require attending the introductory research week
- Graduate interns are encouraged to attend at least one week of the research program
- Priority will be given to Alaska Native/American Indian applicants
- Travel scholarships are available on a limited basis (download application from www.anthc.org/indigenous-research)
- Housing is available at APU
