

Make a Yup'ik Style Paper Plate Mask

Instructions:

1. Cut out desired shape from paper plate (*it can be an animal*).
2. Cut out two holes for eyes.
3. If desired, paint or color the mask.
4. Glue or tape five feathers around the mask.
5. Punch two holes on each side of mask; thread pipe cleaner through holes.
6. Connect the pipe cleaner to fit child's head.
7. Wear mask, and create animal stories or dances together!

Materials:

- Paper Plate
- Five feathers
- Two pipe cleaners
- Hole punch
- Glue or tape
- Water colors or markers, if desired
