
- Historical trauma is cumulative emotional and psychological wounding over the lifespan and across generations, emanating from massive group trauma
- Historical unresolved grief accompanies that trauma

Historical Healing is gathering the pieces broken by historical trauma and stitching them back together in intricate patterns of strength and resiliency





PHO had been raped or coerced in their lifetime. 42% attempted suicide at some point if they had been raped or coerced. 53% lacked permanent housing.

The diank on a weekly or daily basis after they were initially attacked. Only 8% of cases of a rape victim's first attack ended in a comittion. 86% reported being affected by historical trauma.

STORY CREATES meaning

Public Health calls them data points.

I call them Storytellers Of Health.

Why are stories important?

 What is our responsibility to the storyteller?
- Care and protect them from harm What is our responsibility to the story?
- Meaningful intent for the good and wellbeing of the people

SIIS MANNING Cases Were identified across 71 selected urban cities

128 were cases of missing Indigenous women

280 Were cases of murdered Indigenous women

98 were cases with an "unknown status"
