

# Funding Resources for Contaminated Sites


**Purpose of document:** This document was created so a side-by-side comparison could be made between different types of funding programs that are available for contaminated sites in Alaska: Formerly Used Defense Sites (FUDS), the Native American Lands Environmental Mitigation Program (NALEMP), Brownfields, the Contaminated Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act (ANCSA) Lands Assistance Program and EPA Environmental Justice (EJ) Community Change Grants.

**How to use this document:** The different funding programs are separated into columns and are colored-coded: FUDS is red, NALEMP is purple, Brownfields is green, the Contaminated ANCSA Lands Assistance Program is blue, and the EPA EJ Community Change Grants are in yellow. The rows on the first two pages of the document cover what types of sites each program is best for, the requirements for each program, who is eligible to apply for or receive funding, what type of funding it is (for example: grant vs. cooperative agreement), if the application process is competitive (applications are scored, and the highest scoring projects are funded) or non-competitive (as long as application meets the requirements, it will be funded), who you can contact to learn about the different programs; QR codes to that programs website, and what agency is in charge of that funding source.

The last page of the document is color-coded the same as the first two pages for each of the different funding programs but gives information on what entities exist that can help you understand the funding program and assist you in applying for funding (commonly referred to as Technical Assistance Providers).
