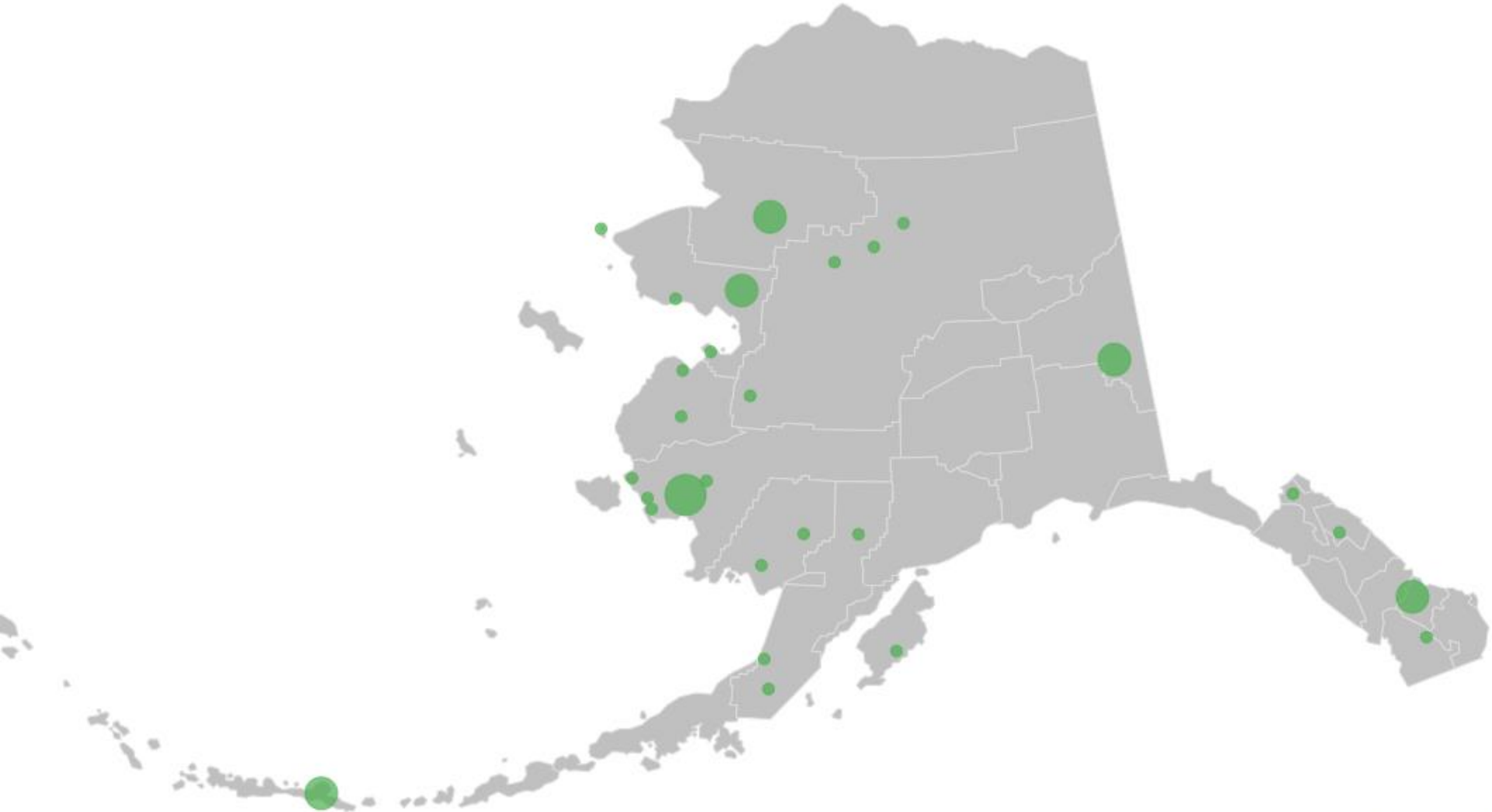

FY24 ANTHC Solid Waste/Resilience Subawards



1	Village of Iliamna	Purchase a baler to reduce the volume of materials and have more efficient shipping with will reduce the cost of waste disposal and streamline waste processing operations.
2	Native Village of Atka	Complete Planning process for selecting a new landfill site, provide community education, landfill site assessment, write report.
3	Village of Solomon	Environmental awareness community event and upcycling workshop.
4	Native Village of Tetlin	One-time-clean up of abandoned, dilapidated and potentially hazardous outhouse in the community.
5	Kipnuk Traditional Council	Purchase solid waste equipment for solid waste management. Purchase ATV and Snowmachine for waste collection. Purchase Smart Ash burner to help meet used oil disposal needs. And attend ARC GIS Mapping training to increase knowledge to monitor erosion concerns.
6	Wrangell Cooperative Association	Purchase a glass crusher, truck and outreach supplies.
7	Native Village of Tuntutuliak	Purchase a burn unit for the landfill. Provide outreach and education in the community.
8	Chefornak Traditional Council	In partnership with the City - The Chefornak Traditional Council will purchase a new burn unit and have it delivered to Chefornak. The landfill is owned and operated by the City - and the Tribe will be providing them the burn unit.
9	Nunakuyarmiut Tribe	Purchase collection bins for outside homes in the community. Bins will have lids to help minimize exposure and improve collection operations.
10	Native Village of Selawik	Maintenance on equipment, develop safety protocols, improve solid waste management at landfill, community gathering.
11	Village of Kotlik	Improvement in waste oil management by purchasing a waste oil burner.
12	Hughes Village Council	Identify unknown liquids in collected 55-gallon barrel drums, backhaul hazardous wastes collected.
13	Anvik Village	Removal of staged old vehicles from the community. Project includes contracting to backhaul.
14	Native Village of Koyuk	Purchase a connex, hire laborers and complete a backhaul project.
15	Huslia Tribal Council	Purchase a burn unit for landfill. Operator training. Provide outreach to the community.
16	Native Village of Napaskiak	Attend several solid waste management trainings, Purchase ATC, and hire landfill operator training.
17	New Koliganek Village Council	Purchasing and installing fencing at the landfill to reduce windblown litter, and control access to he landfill.
18	Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska	Work with local Tribes to develop a regional strategy to address composting and recycling at a local regional level.
19	Stebbins Community Association	Purchase new ATV and trailer to collect e-waste, crap mettle, waste oil and transport to proper disposal site.
20	Native Village of Port Heiden	Marine Debris Clean up crews to complete an assessment and clean up on Shep Creek approximately 20 miles north of Port Heiden and Stroganoff Point approximately 5 miles south of Port Heiden.
21	Native Village of Diomedea	Local hazwoper and Asbestos abatement training.
22	Alutiiq Tribe of Old Harbor	Purchase six bearproof trash containers to place around the community to improve solid waste collection and reduce the access to home trash for wild animals.
23	Organized Village of Kasaan	Purchase glass crusher to begin recycling glass in the community.
24	Chilkat Indian Village, Klukwan	Backhaul staging and removal of white goods and vehicles. Purchase an aluminum can baler.
25	Allakaket Village	Purchase truck to assist with the solid waste collection in community. Develop a recordkeeping system for solid waste collection.
26	Pitka's Point Traditional Council	Solid waste / honey bucket waste collection services. Recycle program outreach with the youth program.
27	Native Village of Manokotak	Purchase ATV and snowmachine to maintain solid waste collection program from homes to landfill year-round. ATV and snowmachine will also assist in backhaul efforts.
28	Chignik Bay Tribal Council (Resilience Application)	Host the Chignik Regional Climate Symposium 2024.
